<u>Marina-</u> The staff is continuing to work on spring preparations, both in water and on land. As far as our slip numbers, on March 22, 2022 we had 331 applications processed. On today, March 28, 2023, we have 322 applications processed.

<u>Lost Marsh Golf Course-</u> Lost Marsh Golf Course is continuing to work on pre-season preparations which includes painting, cutting grass, and software updates. Niko is planning on opening either Monday, April 3rd or Monday, April 10th depending on the weather.

<u>Wolf Lake-</u> Staff has been cleaning up all around. They've cleared up some coyote dens that were out along the shoreline west of the dog park. They also cleared trees and opened the shoreline from 119th Street to the conservatory. The dog park was resanded and leveled, and the fence was repaired. On Sheffield Parkway Wolf Lake staff cleared the dead trees out and are doing some replanting. They cleared part of the east side of 125th Street, on the north side close to PolyJohn.

<u>Lost Marsh Golf Course Netting along 129th Street Discussion and Planning-</u> We are still waiting on some information.

Bin Wall Walkway Repairs & Safety Painting- Marina staff is starting to work on this project.

<u>Indian Creek Blockage</u>. There doesn't seem to be a blockage.

Wolf Lake Water Levels- Unilever adjusted their noncontact cooling water process so they no longer pump water from Lake Michigan eventually into Wolf Lake. They used to pump 5 million gallons of water daily into Wolf Lake, so this may develop into an issue soon. The plan is to talk to Cargill to see if they would be able to change their water flow.
