Call to Order and Roll Call

The April 2, 2024 meeting of the Hammond Port Authority Board of Directors was called to order by Chairman Cantrell at 4:33pm. All five members are present, 3 are in person and 2 are on Zoom. Chairman Cantrell, Vice Chairman Wojdyla, and Secretary/Treasurer Kuhn are present and in person. Member Kaminsky and Member Huerta are present via Zoom.

Interim Port Authority Director N. Sullivan reported on the following:

As of April 1st, the boaters at the marina have started to occupy slips. We are going to start turning on water to the slips next week. The Mayor's Fishing Derby is on April 20th from 7am-4pm. Korellis Roofing is waiting for better weather to start the marina roofing project, and they are expecting to start at the end of April. Staff met with the Data Center, and we are working with them to install an access control gate along with security cameras between properties. Last year on April 11th, the marina had 336 boaters. Today, the marina has 325 boaters with 37 new boaters and 24 on I Dock. Lost Marsh Golf Course officially opened yesterday, April 1st. There weren't too many golfers due to the weather, but there were several membership renewals. We have over 100 golfers booked for this upcoming Saturday alone. We are continuing to book outings. The pro shop is fully stocked and is looking good! At Wolf Lake, Wolf Lake Memorial Park, Forsythe & Amoco Parks, Pavilion, Splash Pad, Conservatory, and Trails we are continuing our spring cleaning efforts on all properties. Paired homes irrigation will be up and running sometime next week. The launch ramp is open, and the ADA ramp has been repaired. The restrooms are now open at Forsythe Park, and at Amoco Park we are working to level out the areas where the old equipment was. The Splash Pad equipment is being tested, and everything seems to be operational. Finally, we will be starting a landscape revamp by the large sign at Wolf Lake and the 2 roundabouts.

Fire Station #2- The project continues to progress and is on schedule.

<u>Marina Administrative Offices/Clipper Room and Boater Facilities Building New Roof-</u> There is some discussion about adding some additional areas onto the project. Koreillis Roofing is expecting to begin work in late April due to the weather.

<u>Fuel Dock Underground Storage Tank Update-</u> Enviroforensics will be getting the bid specs prepared. We are planning on keeping the tanks for another boating season since they are not leaking and we should be changing the insurance policies. We need to check on the lead time for the tanks so we can schedule the bidding properly.

<u>McDermott Way at Casino Center Drive Update-</u> M. Kruszynski is working with Milestone on the city rates for paving. As soon as the plants open, we are hoping to get this scheduled.

<u>Data Center and Marina Gate Access</u>- Data Center is proposing to add a gate at the end of the property with all of our logistics and access control at their cost.
